Sub: Denial of permission to Men-Tse Khang (Sowa Rigpa) Gangchen Kyishong, Distt. Kangra, Dharamsala-176215, Himachal Pradesh) with 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) course for the academic session 2021-22 under section 28/29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 and as per regulation 59(2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- 2. However, GOI, Ministry of AYUSH vide its letter no. L.14011/3/2020-EP (1) dated 26.03.2021 and 15.04.2021 issued Relaxation/support policy for ASU&S colleges in unprecedented times of COVID-19 pandemic for the academic session 2021-22 and the permission for the academic year 2021-22 of the ASU&S colleges will be considered on the basis of part-I visitation proforma submitted by the college provided that the college shall submit an undertaking & indemnity bond, stating that they shall fulfill respective requirements in terms of required teaching and training facilities specified in the relevant regulations throughout the academic year".
- 3. Further, the matter has been placed before 7<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Commission held on 16.11.2021 and the "Commission discussed the matter and considered the request of the college and also directed Medical Assessment Rating Board to issue Denial of permission for the session 2021-22".

4. Therefore, the above said matter has been placed before President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine and he directed to issue denial of permission to Men-Tse Khang (Sowa Rigpa) Gangchen Kyishong, Distt. Kangra, Dharamsala-176215, Himachal Pradesh) with 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) for the academic session 2021-22.

Further, it is informed that the college is being provided a period up to 31.12.2021 to fulfill the shortcomings observed during this year along with the following requirements, so that the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may carry out inspection of the college for consideration of matter for grant of permission for taking admissions in UG (BSRMS) course from the academic year 2022-23.

- (i) All the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 & 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Sowa Rigpa Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2017.
- (ii) All the Requirements of "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard of Educations in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2017 (for sowa Rigpa college); and
- (iii) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
- 5. This is issued with the approval of Competent Authority.
